The four year olds also explored winter and winter weather. They talked about animals in winter, and how some animals hibernate, some migrate, and others adapt. They also focused on Arctic animals and penguins. The four year olds enjoyed a number of different literacy activities based on the story "The Mitten." They enjoyed retelling the story using the large mitten and stuffed animals.
