We encourage our students to "be who you are and be that well" in their academic and spiritual life and to embrace their unique journey, where the destination is not the only goal. There are times when their path is straight and times when it is winding, with successes and challenges along the way. And, more often than not, there are wonderful realizations and important discoveries made because of the route chosen.

During this year's Day of Giving on February 10, 2022, we invite you to shape the next steps in our journey as we **SOAR** together at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic School. We focus on our **S**trengths, **O**pportunities, **A**dvancements, and **R**esults, we embrace and advance the next generation of innovators, educators, learners, and faithful leaders.

- We will install an Air Filtration System to improve the resiliency of the school against COVID-19, allergens, and other future contaminants.
  - All classrooms will have their own dedicated heating and cooling unit, which will allow for the comfort and consistency of temperature control in each room. This prevents cross-ventilation and contaminants from being shared between classrooms while improving air quality.
- We plan infrastructure upgrades throughout the school to enhance safety, accessibility, well-being, and a sense of belonging for our Wildcats, now and into the future.
  - We are responding to a Diocesan recommendation to enhance the security of our entrances with concrete bollards, and we will upgrade all doors and locks in the school building to comply with ADA standards and reinforce safety measures.
- We aim to redesign the Science Lab to foster a collaborative STREAM environment, which will build upon the success of the Academic Support Center last year.
  - The intended use of this room will move beyond traditional Science instruction to provide opportunities for students to take thoughtful risks, engage in experiential learning, persist in problem-solving, and collaborate in the creative process.
- We will initiate phase 2 of the flooring renovation by extending it into shared spaces.

- Phase 1 was received so positively from a visual, health, and cleanliness standpoint that the extension of the luxury vinyl tile into high-traffic areas is the appropriate next step.

In recognition of her 18 years of service and commitment, The Wildcat Fund will dedicate this year's Day of Giving to our principal, Mrs. Adrienne Jewett, and will name the Academic Support Center in her honor.

When we embrace our journey forward, we discover the limitless potential that will allow our school to **SOAR** for generations to come. As we invest in our mission, our students, and our teachers, we collaborate, cultivate, and celebrate rising higher in academics and in Christ.
