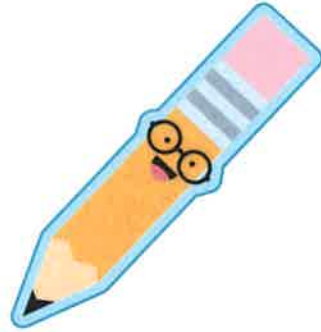


# Spelling Activities



Dear Parents,

Listed below are the spelling activities your child may wish to complete each week. Here are some rules for completing these weekly activities:

1. Your child must choose enough activities to equal 60 points for each week, unless otherwise noted.
2. Activities are due **every Thursday morning**, unless otherwise noted. Activities should be completed on loose leaf paper with proper heading on each page to include the child's name, number, date and spelling activity *including point value*.
3. An activity may only be done once per week (i.e. there cannot be 2 oral tests in the same week).
4. No more than half of the weekly points may be "parent signature" type activities.
5. Activities **must** be completed in neatest handwriting.

## Activities worth 20 points:

1. Write your words neatly 5 times each.
2. Divide each word into syllables.
3. Write sentences using **10** words from your list. Sentences should be written using **8 or more words**. Underline each spelling word.
4. Create a crossword puzzle with clues & give to someone to solve.
5. Make and solve a word search.
6. Create an acrostic using your spelling words. Write each letter on a line. Find words that begin with each letter. You may choose **10** words from your list.
7. Make spelling pyramids. Write the first letter on the first line, on the next line, write the first and second letters, on the third, write the first, second and third letters and so on. Continue this process until all words are written.
8. Create a poem using **10** words.
9. Create a greeting card using **10** of your words. Don't forget the illustration!
10. Create an advertisement for a new product. Use **10** of your words.

## Activities worth 15 points:

1. Write your words neatly 3 times.
2. Write your words in ABC order.
3. Write a story using your spelling words.

4. Make a list of words that rhyme with the spelling words.
5. Take a written practice test and make corrections in a different colored pen.
6. Secret Agent Words: Convert your spelling words to numbers (ex. A=1, B=2, C=3, D=4, etc...)
7. First, write your spelling word, and then write it backwards. Continue until all words are written.

**Activities worth 10 points:**

1. Smooth out some shaving cream on a cookie sheet & spell the words. **Parent signature required for completion of this activity.**
2. Use pieces of yarn to spell out your words on the floor. **Parent signature required to show you have completed this activity.**
3. Using clay or playdough, roll the dough out like a snake & spell the words. **Parent signature required for completion of this activity.**
4. Dribble a ball or jump rope while spelling your words. **Parent signature required.**
5. Take an oral practice test. **Parent signature required.**
6. Write the words and circle all the vowels using a **blue colored pencil or pen.**
7. Write the words and circle all the consonants using a **green colored pencil or pen.**
